Journey Church is a "Heart of the Home" sponsor for this home build.

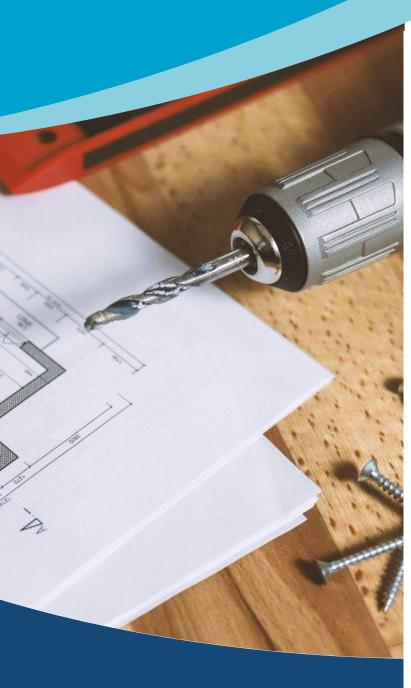




- 5311 17th Avenue (11th new build) drywall is currently being installed.

Strengthen Brand Image

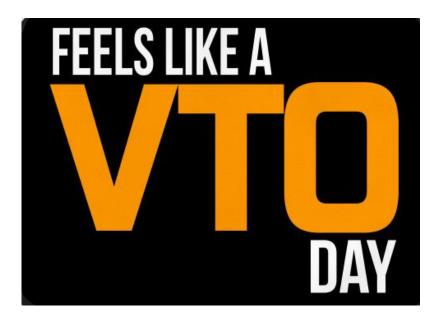
55% of consumers are willing to pay a higher price for a product or service offered by a company that advocates social causes.
