what we are currently doing in our community...


- We will be scheduling a home dedication for 2215 67th St in the near future.

Habitat for Humanity International strongly recommends that affiliates limit "on-site" and other in-person volunteers to regular *skilled* volunteers who work with the affiliate eight or more hours each month. Again, this recommendation is grounded in our shared commitment to health and safety.

Our affiliate always strives to be in line with Habitat for Humanity International. This being said, starting on **Monday, August 10th** (until further notice) we will limit our volunteering on the build site to only our Site Leaders, Carpenter's Club members, future Homeowners, and Homeowners friends/family who are donating sweat equity.

Give Tide ...

Never underestimate the power of your spare change! Download the GiveTide app and send your spare change to HFHK to help us further our mission here in Kenosha.

After you have attached your bank, GiveTide will automatically round up the spare change on your everyday purchases to the nearest dollar. You can set a weekly cap to automatically turn off roundups after a specific amount.

Your roundups are periodically charged to your account and transferred to a fiduciary donor-advised fund. Your in-app donations are relayed to the donor-advised fund, which executes them on your behalf.

This structure creates a seamless donation experience, while simultaneously protecting the integrity of your donations.
